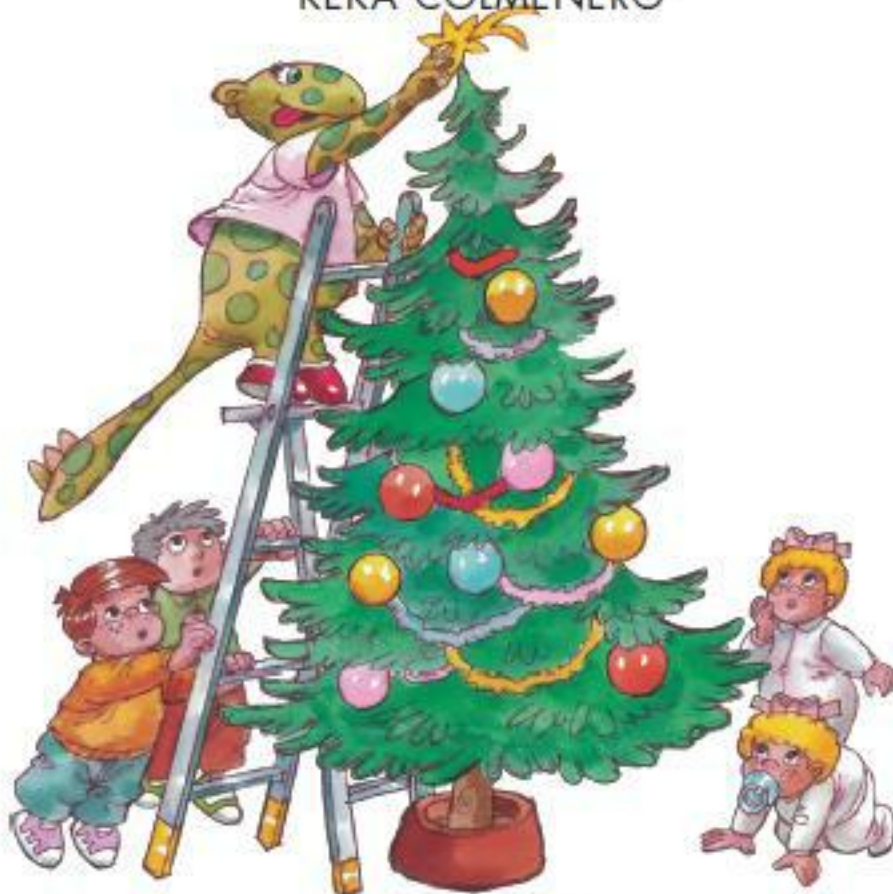

It was Christmas time and at Alex's they were all decorating the house.

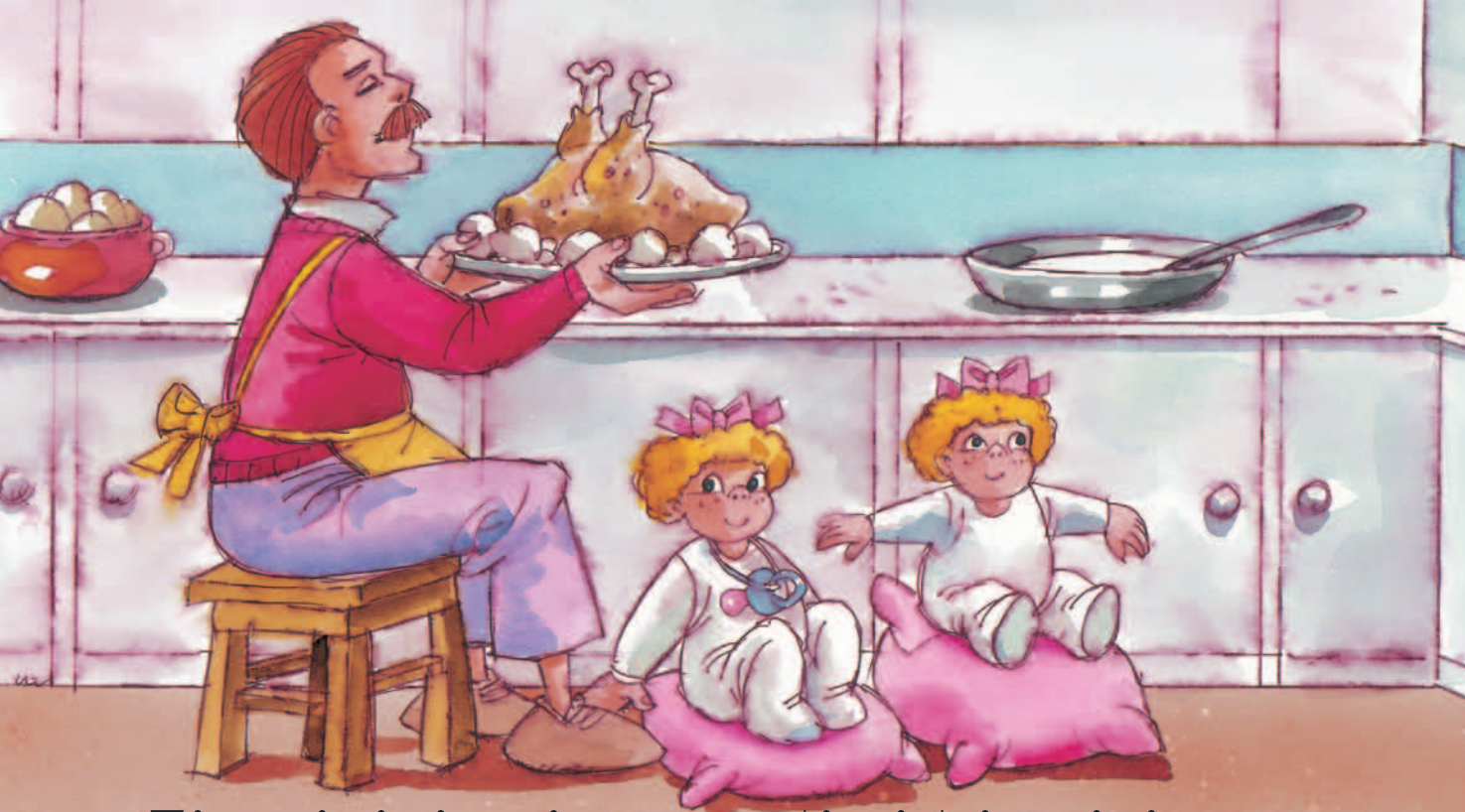
"Christmas is beautiful!" Pancho exclaimed.
