"Never? You can come to mine!"





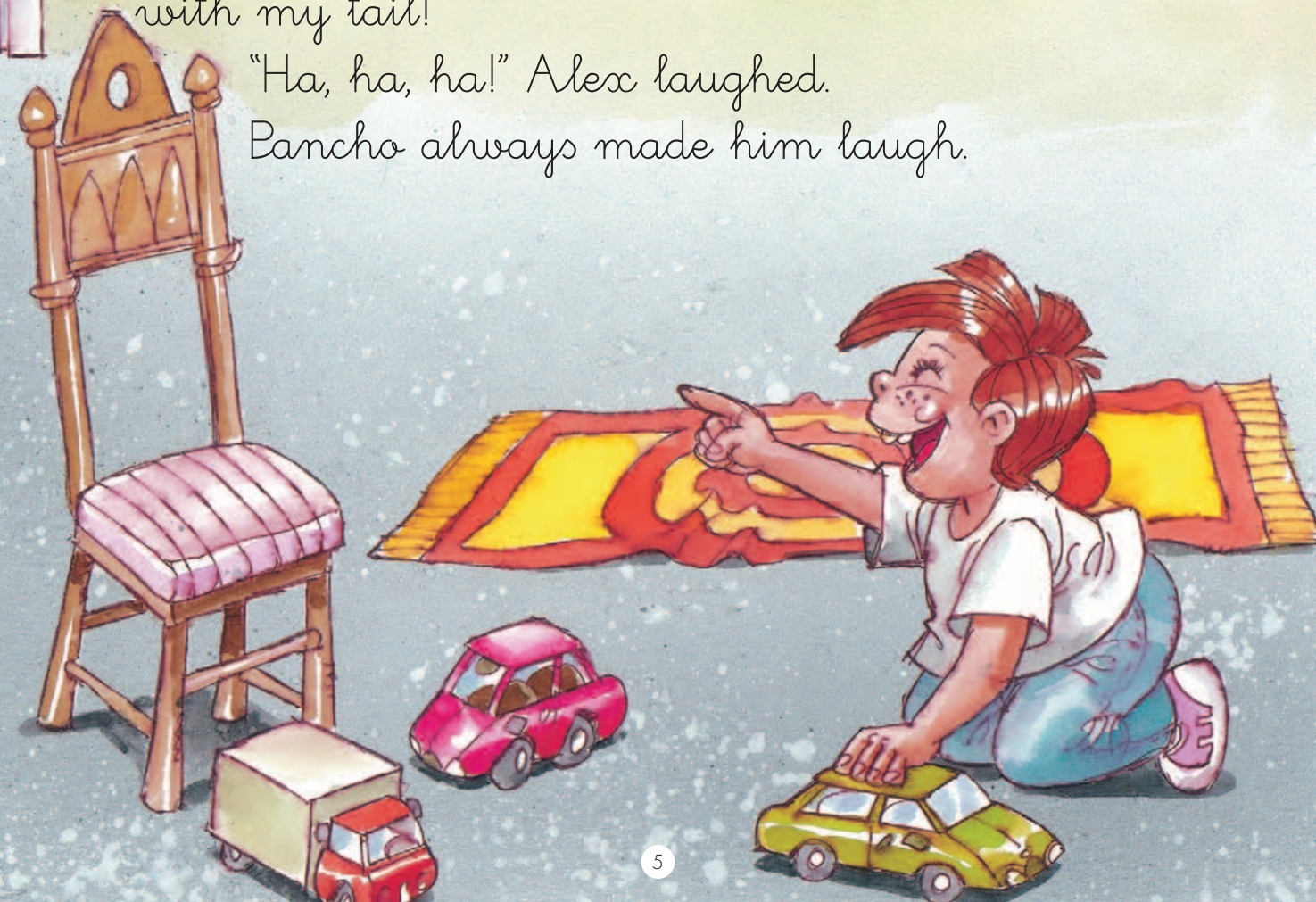


Pancho was so happy that he started to jump, but his tail got in his way, he slipped on the toy cars and crash! He fell on his nose.
